

PRIMARY DAY IS AUGUST 11, 2020 ELECTION DAY IS NOVEMBER 3, 2020

You may register as a voter in Connecticut if you meet the following criteria:

- You are a U.S. citizen and CT resident who will be at least 18 by Election Day.
- You meet the criteria above and have completed confinement and parole if previously convicted of a felony.

**Voter Registration Deadlines: Online and By Mail and in Person:
Primary-August 6, or In person Aug. 10; November 3 Election- October 27**

You can register online at <https://voterregistration.ct.gov> if you have a CT DMV-issued driver's license or drivers' permit. When open, you can register in person with the Registrars of Voters at Ridgefield Town Hall or download a form and mail it in to Town Hall, 400 Main St., Ridgefield <https://portal.ct.gov/sots/LIB/sots/ElectionServices/ElectForms/electforms/ed671.pdf>

Election Day Registration: If you missed the October 27th deadline, Ridgefielders can register on Election Day, November 3rd at the Ridgefield Town Hall, 400 Main Street. 6 am – 8 pm. Bring ID and be prepared to wait in line! There is no EDR for the August Primary.

Polls are Open: 6 am – 8pm **Polling Locations:** District 1: East Ridge Middle School; Districts 2: Scotts Ridge Middle School; District 3: Yanity Gym; District 4: Scotts Ridge Middle School **8/11 Primary - One Polling Location only – East Ridge Middle School**

Absentee Ballot Applications: Under normal circumstances, CT does not have convenience absentee voting. **During the Covid-19 Pandemic however, eligible voters may vote in the August 11, 2020 Primary and November 3, 2020 Election by absentee.** Ballot applications have been mailed to eligible voters for 8/11/20. Voters must fill out the application and return it to receive an Absentee Ballot.
