VOTER INFORMATION

You may **register** to vote **in Connecticut** if you meet the following criteria:

- You are a U.S. citizen and a resident of a CT Town who will be 18 by Election Day.
- You meet the criteria above and have completed confinement and parole if previously convicted of a felony.

Voter Registration Deadlines: By Mail & Online, October 16; In person at Town Hall by 8pm

Early Voting: October 19 - November 1, 10 am-6 pm; extended hours on 10/27 and 10/29, 8 am-8 pm at Town Hall, 400 Main St. Lower Level Conference Room.

Same Day Registration: During Early Voting or on Election Day at Town Hall, 400 Main St.

Bring a current ID, proof of current residential address and be prepared to wait in line!

Absentee Ballots: Available October 2: (Open to all voters, No Excuse Necessary!)

Must fill out an Absentee Ballot application to get a ballot. Apply Online at: <https://oabr-sots.ct.gov/OABR/absenteeBallotReqPortalHome.do> with a valid CT DMV ID beginning

September 19, **or** download and fill out the [English Application for Absentee Ballot](#) anytime.

Ballot applications and/or Ballots may be mailed (if time allows); placed in the Ballot Drop Box by the Town Hall Front Door, or brought in person to the Town Clerk's Office. If mailing, please leave sufficient time to allow for round-trip mailings of the application and the ballot. Completed ballots must be received by Nov. 3 at 8 pm.

Regular hours for Town Hall are Monday – Thursday, 8 am – 5:30 pm.
