It's too late to switch parties for the primaries , but it's not too late to register for the first time or affiliate with a party if you haven't yet. You may **register** as a voter **in Connecticut** if you meet the following criteria:

- **You are a U.S. citizen and a resident of a CT Town who will be 18 by Election Day.**
- **Have completed confinement and parole if previously convicted of a felony.**

## **Absentee Voting Information**

Connecticut law allows you to receive an absentee ballot if you cannot appear at your assigned polling place on election day because of: active service in the Military; absence from the town; sickness; religious tenets forbid secular activity on the day of the election; duties as an election official at a polling place other than your own during all of the hours of voting, or physical disability. **To receive an absentee ballot you must complete and sign an absentee ballot application** and return it to the Town Clerk at 400 Main Street, Ridgefield.
